- International relations is a major subfield of political science, primarily concerned with international relations theory.
- It is also concerned with world politics, global politics, international politics, and international studies.
- Usually, the "relative balance of power" is concerned with the relationships among the governments of the world and the relationships of states to other entities, such as the United Nations, international organizations, and individuals.

- The relative power of states includes war, peace, diplomacy, foreign policy, international organizations, international institutions, international law, the global environment, ethnic conflicts, human rights, security studies, world population trends, and international relations.
- Politics is the struggle for power. International politics is the struggle for power on a global stage.
- Power is the ability to make people or things do what they otherwise would not have done. Hard power is measured by a nation's military, economic, and political strength. Soft power is based on the ability of a nation-state to attract its goals through persuasion and diplomacy rather than military force.

- All countries have borders and a territory, the economic model of the state is a theoretical, although the real-world model of diplomats with practical economics and political issues.
- Political scientists who specialize in IR attempt to explain what world politics is, how it works, what it does, and predict what it will do. In fact, they use qualitative and quantitative research methods.

INTRODUCTION

- The international system is composed of nation-states, individuals, international organizations, transnational organizations, and transnational corporations.
- The modern international system comprising independent nation-states emerged after the 1918 Treaty of Versailles.
- Over time, the pre-war Wilsonian system gave way to the one of the right of conquest.
- The international system is the result of the balance of power by the West, the pre-war European powers and the United States.
- The balance of power in the world periodically shifts.
- From 1945 (the end of the Thirty Years' War) to 1971 (the end of World War II), there was a **multilateral system**.
- Following 1945 and the collapse of the Soviet Union in 1991, there was a bipolar world and an East-West axis between the United States and the Soviet Union.
- Following the collapse of the Soviet Union, the United States was left as the world's dominant superpower.
- A modified multipolar world is emerging with the balance of power spread between the United States, Russia, China, the European Union, and the EU.
- A significant characteristic of the 21st century international system is the shift in the balance of power between the growth of the global north and from existence of the global south.
- The countries of the North (e.g., Europe and North America) are referred to as **economically developed countries** or the **First World**.
- The global south consists primarily of Africa, Asia, Latin America, and the Middle East and are referred to as **less economically developed countries** or the **Third World**.

- The terms First, Second, and Third World have evolved from the term used during the American Revolution in 1776 and the end of the Civil War in 1865.
- First World:** Originally the countries aligned with the United States and its allies during the Cold War, the term is now associated with oil wealth, industrialized capitalism, democratic, technologically developed countries, compared to the global south, the average income per capita gross domestic product (GDP) is high, literacy and education rates are high, life expectancy is high, and life spans are long.
- Second World:** Originally aligned with the Soviet Union and China during the Cold War, this term has mostly lost its original meaning in the modern language of IR.
- Third World:** Originally misaligned countries, mostly in Africa, Asia, and South America, the term used with the end of the Cold War for the Soviet Union and China. In the Cold War, the term is now associated with the post-colonialized (i.e. in the process of independence), less economically developed countries. They are often transitioning to democracy, many were colonized by the European powers, compared to the global south, the average income per capita GDP is low, literacy and education rates are low, life expectancy is low, and life spans are short. The term "Third World" is not associated in most contexts and is "less economically developed" is often used as alternative.
- Fourth World:** The poorest of the poor countries of the world, the indigenous peoples of the world, and the poorest living in the most violent First World countries.

Evolution of the International System

- 1. Monarchical system (300 BC - 1500 AD):** A period with the end of the Thirty Years' War in 1648 and the Treaty of Westphalia, which established absolute monarchies as the sole actors on the world stage.
- 2. Multipolar system with power distributed between Great Britain, France, Austria, Spain, Russia, and the Ottoman Empire:**
 - Influenced by the political ideas of John Locke and Jean-Jacques Rousseau.

- 3. Industrial Revolution begins in England:** A period with the end of the American Revolution in 1776 and the French Revolution in 1789.
- 4. Pre-war system (1895-1914):**
 - Begins with the Congress of Vienna (1814-1815), which ended the Napoleonic Wars in Europe.
 - Multilateral distribution of power between Germany, Austria-Hungary, France, Britain, and Russia.
 - War of nationalism and Marxism, nationalism, and Christianity.
 - Creation of the Balkan states.
 - Industrialization in Europe and continuation of European colonization.
 - Trade with the rest of World I.
- 5. Interwar system (1918-1939):**
 - Beginning World War I, the Treaty of Versailles, and the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk.
 - Multilateral distribution of power between Britain, France, Germany, Japan, the United States, and the Soviet Union.
 - Creation of the League of Nations.
 - War of fascism, Hitler, and communism.
 - Marked by the Great Depression.
 - Trade with the rest of World II.
- 6. Cold War (1945-1991):**
 - Begins with the end of World War II.
 - The Iron Curtain.
 - The Berlin Wall.
 - The US is founded.
 - Bipolar distribution of power between the United States and the Soviet Union.
 - Colonized countries gain their independence.
 - Trade with the rest of the two superpowers.
 - Trade with the rest of the world as China and the integration of economies in the 1990s.
- 7. Post-Cold War system (1990s-Present):**
 - A world with the collapse of the Soviet Union.
 - The United States remains as dominant military power.
 - Demolitionism in Eastern Europe.
 - Emergence of the European Union.
 - The end of the Cold War.
 - The process of globalization.
 - September 11, 2001, 9/11, 9/11, 9/11.
 - Marked by wars in Iraq and Afghanistan.
