


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Red Flags Of Love Fraud - 10 Signs You're Dating A Sociopath

These people are social predators, who live their lives by exploiting others. Three million to 12 million sociopaths live among us in America. Most are not in jail--they roam freely through all segments of society. They like company, and they really like sex, so sociopaths are always on the hunt for a hookup. This book explains how sociopaths target and pursue romantic relationships, which are inevitably exploitative relationships. The information is based on more than 2,800 cases that Andersen has collected through Lovefraud.com, and on the results of two Internet surveys completed by Lovefraud readers who loved and lived with these human predators. Donna Andersen is author of *Red Flags of Love Fraud - 10 signs you're dating a sociopath*. She is also author of *Lovefraud.com*, a website and blog that teaches people how to recognize and recover from sociopaths. Andersen learned about sociopaths the hard way--by marrying one. In two-and-a-half years, her husband defrauded her of \$227,000, cheated on her with at least six women, fathered a child with one of them, and then, 10 days after Andersen left him, married the mother of the child. It was the second time he committed bigamy. She tells the whole outrageous story in her first book, *Love Fraud - How marriage to a sociopath fulfilled my spiritual plan*. This man had no conscience, no empathy and lied prolifically--which Andersen discovered, far too late, were the cardinal signs of a sociopath. In 2005, Andersen launched *Lovefraud.com* to educate the public about this destructive personality disorder. *Lovefraud.com* now receives almost 3,000 visits every day, and is considered the best source on the Internet about relationships with sociopaths. Andersen has collected more than 3,800 cases of people targeted by sociopaths, and the *Lovefraud* blog has evolved into a healing community of survivors. Andersen receives many e-mails from

people who thank Lovefraud for saving their lives. Andersen has worked as a freelance copywriter since 1983, and was the original editor of Atlantic City Magazine from 1978 to 1982. She graduated summa cum laude from the Syracuse University's S. I. Newhouse School of Public Communications in 1978. While at college she co-founded a student magazine and worked at the student newspaper, the Daily Orange.

This book was extremely eye-opening. I found out recently that I was married to a sociopath for nearly 5 years. I divorced him a year ago, but I am still finding out stuff about him and I'm not even soliciting this information! This book was frighteningly accurate. No, my ex-husband did not exhibit all 10 red flags. Nor was he physically abusive towards me, though I found out he has been towards other women in the past. But it was shocking how much he fit the "profile," as he exhibited most signs of sociopathy. Reading this book was in some ways very hard for me, but it was also very healing. Now I feel like I have a sense of closure with that relationship because I understand things. Also, I have been very fearful about dating and ending up with someone else just like him. After reading this, I feel a little more confident. I will never again be able to miss the signs of a sociopath - even if I wanted to! I'm intimately familiar. Plus, reading all the excerpts from other women's letters made me feel better; at least I'm not the only one. And I see now how much worse my situation could have been!

For anyone dating or in a dysfunctional relationship this is an important book to read! Once you realize the signs of a sociopath, and realize how easy they are to spot through all of the charm and control of the abuser, you will be armed with the ability to either avoid or exit the very painful cost and heartache of being in a relationship with one.
