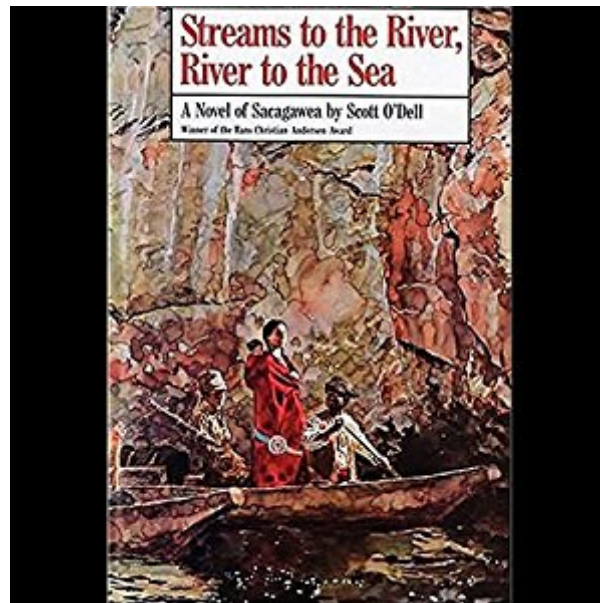




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Streams To The River, River To The Sea: A Novel Of Sacagawea
