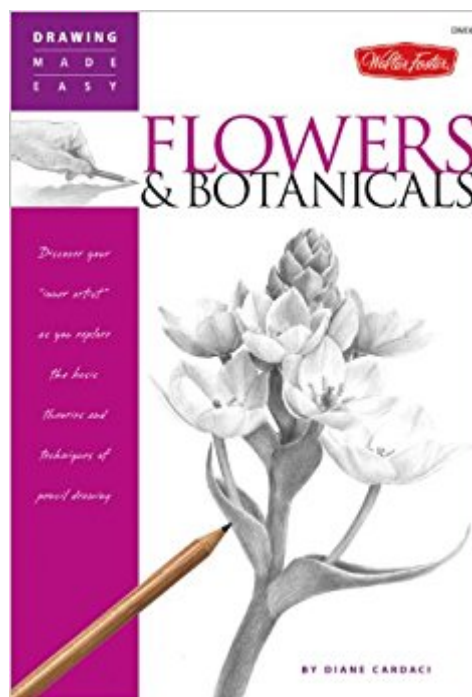

Her passion for both realism and nature led her to start her professional art career working as a Natural Science Illustrator in New York City, where she specialized in medical and natural science illustrations. Her work has been published by the American Museum of Natural History in New York City, as well as by major textbook companies such as Holt, Rinehart, and Winston. After studying portraiture with such nationally acclaimed artists such as Nelson Shanks and John Sanden, commissioned portrait work soon became an important

To be clear, this book contains no sections on color techniques, focusing on black and white (charcoal and graphite). It is a super little book, easy to carry around with great directions on sketching, toning and shading botanicals, techniques that are beneficial for all types of drawing. New and budding artists should enjoy and benefit from this as well as those like me who have been away from it for a while. I am finding it great for practice exercise and remembering forgotten techniques.
