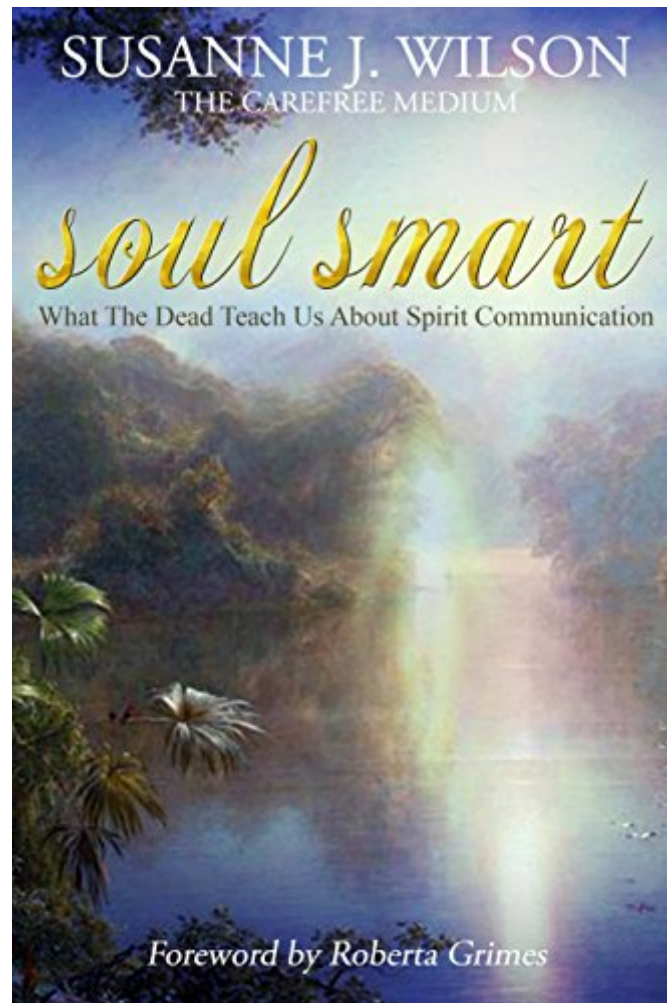




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Soul Smart

As Susanne's sister, my review is certainly not objective, but I do have a unique opportunity to provide feedback and verification of many of her experiences throughout her life. I am a first-hand witness to many of these events and revelations detailed in her book. I can honestly say, it's all true. Our family has a long history of what they used to call 'seers' and she's been one since we were kids. The mind blowing examples of spirit communication in her book are real experiences, with real people. Knowing the validity of her interactions and direct communication with other worldly beings, I do believe she has an insider view of what's waiting for us when we pass on. Some of her (and many other's) beyond life descriptions may seem far-fetched. But given that many mediums obtain the same information, it's possible these explanations are merely beyond our understanding. But you obviously have no reason to believe me. If you are new to world of mediumship, browsing for a good read, or a well seasoned traveler on this journey of who we are, there is something for you in this well written book. Susanne's presentation is like taking a class to learn about soul communication. She not only presents her life story that brought her to develop her natural mediumship, she also has stories of validations in readings and signs by spirit, synchronistic events, how to recognize spirit guides and angels in your life, dream visits, tips and techniques to make your own connections with loved ones. I have read numerous books on mediumship, mediums, afterlife studies. This book is one of my favorites! I hope you enjoy it as much as I did/do!

Soul Smart is a great addition to the rapidly growing literature on spirituality written primarily by mediums or students of their works. Other books in this genre can leave the reader feeling as if only highly talented, genetically predisposed, and well-trained individuals can communicate with spirits. In contrast, author Susanne Wilson, a professional medium, points out that everyone communicates with spirits routinely, whether we know it or not. Often people dismiss attempts by spirits to communicate as coincidences, wish fulfillment, or meaningless hallucinations. Wilson normalizes speaking with dead people and provides simple techniques anyone can use to enhance that communication. In this respect, Soul Smart fills an important gap in this literature that some refer to as the New Revelation. This revelation concerns the spiritual nature of human beings, the purpose of life, the continuity of consciousness after the physical body dies, and what people do while

discarnate (e.g., conduct a past life review, decide upon the need for another incarnation, study universal laws, serve as guides). Susanne Wilson is a certified mental medium who discerns details that provide evidence of the identity of a spirit. She has undergone stringent laboratory procedures developed by Professor Gary Schwartz at the University of Arizona that suggest her accuracy is close to 85% (it is rare for a medium to do better than that in controlled settings). So the reader can feel fairly confident about the veracity of what she has to say about the nature of spirit and the afterlife. *Soul Smart* is divided into two parts plus appendices. In Part 1, there is a clear and concise summary of the major spiritual concepts that have been relayed over the past century. Wilson describes how she has experienced spirit communication since childhood and how she learned the hard way that a pure profit motive interferes with this ability. Examples of other topics in Part 1 include the death process (including for children and people who committed suicide) and the activities people undertake while discarnate. One of these activities is for a spirit to learn how to communicate with people who are incarnate. However, as with all communication, it is a two-way street. In order to learn how to better talk with dead people, Part 2 and the appendices list a variety of techniques that can initiate communication as well as ways to recognize attempts by spirits to communicate. Techniques primarily involve the use of specialized meditation and invited dream visits. Clues that a spirit is talking include not only dream visitations but also recognition of symbols, particularly in the form of unusual behavior of insects, birds, and other small animals. Wilson is not alone in her assertion that communicating with spirits is a natural thing to do. Researchers (e.g., Arcangel, Guggenheim) have found that at least 60% of people report spontaneous spirit communication but are often afraid to share those experiences. The fear pertains to being judged negatively, eschewed, and even diagnosed as having a mental disorder. The fields of Psychiatry and Psychology are OK with prayer but pathologize anyone who gets a response! So the prevalence of spontaneous spirit communication is probably much greater than 60%. In addition, some psychologists (e.g., Botkin, Greer) have utilized speaking to spirits as part of psychotherapy for a range of problems in living, including complicated grief and post-traumatic stress. In other words, communicating with spirits is not only normal and natural, it is also healthy. The writing is clear, concise, and straightforward. Concepts are simplified for the novice to this literature. Perhaps sometimes a bit too simplified. For example, the author refers to "vibrations" and the "astral plane" without providing a definition of these terms. It is recognized that spirits experience grief and love but little is said about other emotions such as anger, fear, and jealousy (desire to emulate). I also think that the notion of "lower realms" is dealt with too concisely.

There is brief mention of "negative" entities called Collectors but the origin and nature of them are unspecified. This is an important issue because the New Revelation literature in general tends to reject the notion of a Satan and a Hell so I wish the author had addressed this issue in greater detail. For these reasons I offered 4 stars. Overall, I highly recommend this book for a summary of the New Revelation literature and most importantly for the instructions provided on how to recognize and enhance communication with dead people.

From her year's of mediumship Susanne is able to give a beautiful clear picture of what the afterlife is really like. Susanne's meditation transcripts are wonderful and easy to follow. This kindlebook of Soul Smart by Susanne Wilson is very therapeutic for people who believe in celestial spirit ally teams and connection with the higher self. Wilson gives different techniques for reaching out to a person's celestial ally team, a friend and/or family member in spirit, ways that celestial connection and signs are established.
