Shinkman, manages to explain Israelis and their way of life to a Westerner, in a way that is accurate and above all, makes you laugh out loud.....it would have been so helpful to have this book while living there. Shinkman is balancing delicately on the fine line between caricature and information. But thanks to his great sense of humour and what seems like a profound love for Israel, he manages to pull it off...The second reason for not giving it a fifth star is that the cover is dull. And this book is everything but dull. I would even say that is worth a read even if you are not going to Israel.
