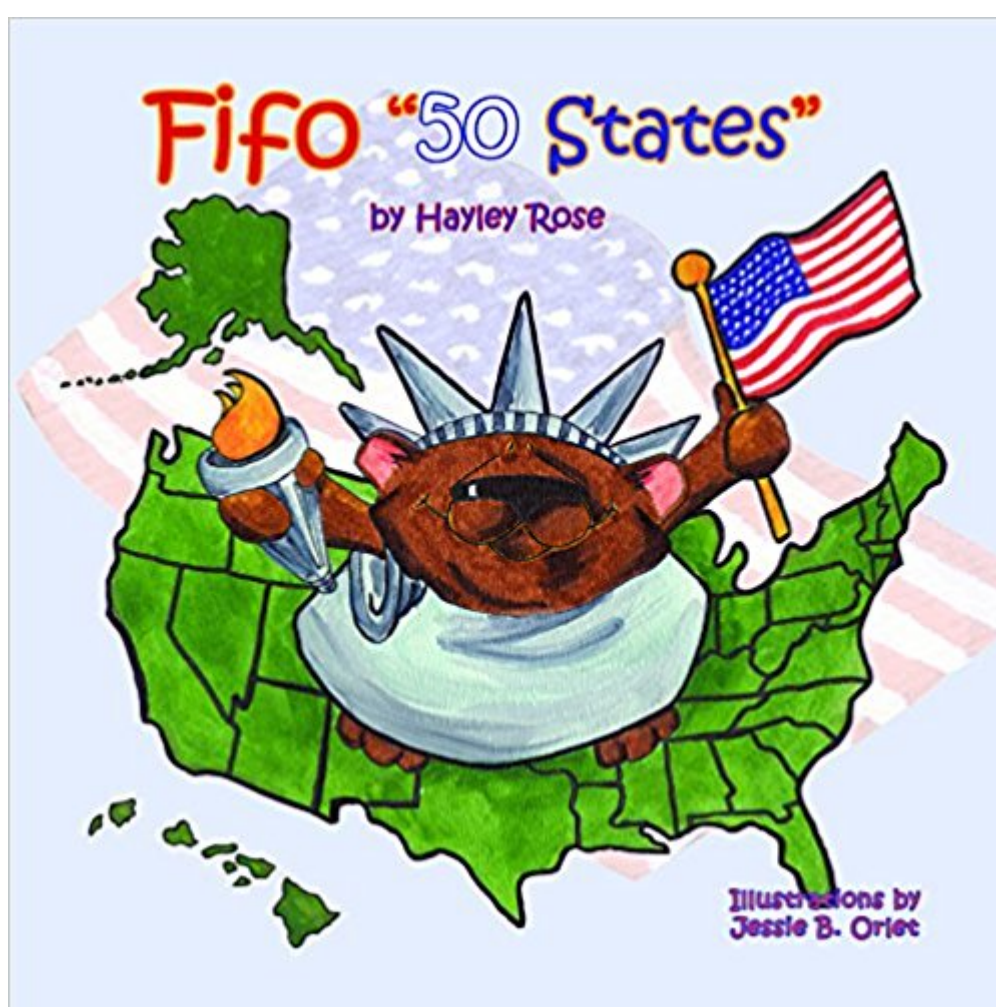

Our friend, Fifo, is travelling all around the country, from one state to the other in alphabetical order. Every page is about a state and there is a really nice picture too! Through this lovely journey, children get to learn a few things about each state in a rhythm! There is the state name and the capital and its numbering too! There is also the state flower, tree and bird in that little poem! In the bottom of the page, our little friends can read the state's motto!!! On the other page, that hosts a picture about the state, there is always Fifo, doing what somebody would do in that state, like surfing in Hawaii or canoeing in Idaho! All the nice things that are part of the poem are visible in the picture too! As well as the state map is drawn somewhere highlighted with the state initials! There is also a bit of the state's history hidden in there along with any kind of activities or festivities that make the state known! One can also see the crops, orchards or animals to be found in the state, which is very nice for the children to see! The illustration is done by Jesse B. Orlet and is really enjoyable! The lovely bear, the beautiful state scenes, the animals, birds and nature represent each state quite lovely!

The illustrations in this book are what really caught my eye. The pictures are vivid, whimsical, and so well detailed, with different scenes that capture the character of each state. The book itself is

simple to read and features a repeating rhyme that acts as a container for the facts within. Even as an adult I learned something while reading, because I'm shamefully inept at remembering the state capitals. Along with the basic facts on each state, though, I would have loved to see something a little quirkier, like a fun fact for each state. I think this would have helped break up the repetition of the narrative, which at times felt a bit restrictive to me. Overall, though, I think this book is a great educational resource for schools, and I could certainly see it as a staple on the bookshelves of elementary-age children. Fifo's *50 States* has everything you could want in a children's book: colorful art, sing-songy text, and informational dialogue. The artistry of the book is truly delightful; each image is simplistic in style and yet full of cuddly characters and rich scenes. They capture the imagination and supplement the words nicely. Fifo, himself, is a great character for children to follow. They come along as he travels all over the country and tells them about each place. There are key, easily remembered bits of information such as the capitals of the states, state flowers, and other small details. Each section is composed like a poem, with the first four lines almost identically matching that of the other states. It easily sets up the homey ambiance of any children's novel. I would highly recommend it as an introduction to different states for kids. It doesn't tell a story so much as just bounce from state to state, so there definitely needs to be some interest in the subject matter. Hayley Rose does it again with her award-winning *Fifo's 50 States*, illustrated by Jessie B. Orlet. In its pages, Rose takes young readers on a journey across the continental 48, with a jaunt to Alaska in the far northwest, as well as one to Hawaii in the far southwest. Set out in alphabetical order, the information for each state includes the number of its entry into the union, the name of its capital, and details about its state flower, tree, bird, and slogan. The illustrations in *Fifo's 50 States*, provide added details that emphasize what each state is best known for, ranging from unusual weather, to natural wonders, to industry. It will open doors for parents to discuss the details with their children, helping to acquaint them with the states and with interesting tidbits about each, perhaps preparing them for their own journeys of discovery in the future.
