

The leaders--from Margaret Sanger and Betty Friedan to bell hooks and the president of Planned Parenthood, Gloria Feldt--argue passionately for abortion as a civil right and show how it is connected to birth control. Many writers discuss what led to Roe v. Wade and warn that reproductive choice is still at risk, and there are some strong individual accounts ("I had an illegal abortion").
