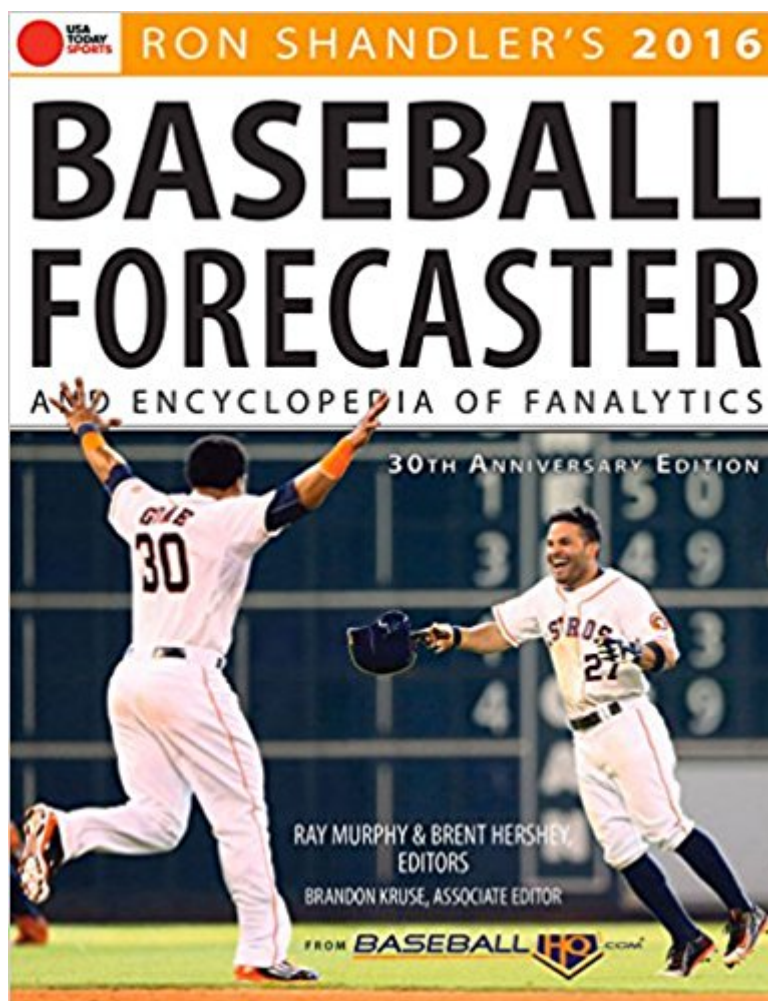

I love the Forecaster. I've been reading it faithfully for years. I was excited when I saw that this year they had come out with the Kindle version. I was curious to see how they were going to modify the player profiles to make them readable on the Kindle. So today I paid for the Kindle version. I regretted my decision immediately. No adjustments or modifications were made to the player profiles for the Kindle version. As you can see from the picture below the profiles are useless. They are unreadable. You can double-click on a player's profile and bring it up as a picture file, but then you have to expand each player individually to be able to make anything out. What a colossal fail! Is there anyway that I can get my money back, so that I can buy the paperback version instead?

If you need the charts in this book (which really is the whole reason for buying it) do NOT buy the Kindle version. You can't read them. As far as I could tell, they do not have the PDF files posted anywhere for viewing or download so you're stuck with these itty bitty tiny things that an ant couldn't read. I was excited to see it on Kindle, then when I saw that they'd taken no efforts to make it usable, I returned it for a refund. Get the print book, which remains a usable resource, or subscribe to their website. But don't buy the Kindle. It won't work for you.

My copy has all its pages. I've been getting the Forecaster every year for the past decade. It's a roto player's bible. I always enjoy the crispness of the cover and pages, when my copy arrives. Because by the end of the season, this thing is a dog-eared, marked-up rag.

An excellent resource for fantasy leaguers and avid fans alike. The authors spare us the arcane witticisms that are found in higher-priced and less informative alternatives. The sabermetrics are abundant, but at a level even the more casual fan can understand. The 'picks' and 'pans' offer a variety of opinions regarding seasonal expectations of current players.

Get this book every year for the past 7 years when I was first told about it by a fellow member of SABR (Society of Baseball Researchers) I found that it was a great tool not only for fantasy players but also could be of great value to actual GMs in the real world of MLB.

I ordered this to help me with my fantasy baseball draft. This is way too much for my purposes. If you want to put together a spreadsheet with formulas on all the aspects of baseball and plug in all

the players, this book is a good start.

Not the only source I use for fantasy baseball, but always the first source I go to. So many statistical, analytical and anecdotal gems in this book each year. It is THE resource for anyone who seriously enjoys this ridiculously silly hobby.
