

Heart pounding rapid action with our heroine fighting divided loyalties and attraction. The prince of

hell turned out to be a totally different then previously implied. The good guys aren't good and the evil guys are not bad. The fights and narrow escapes, the sacrifices and the devotion are deeply affecting the arc of the story.

I had a hard time following things at the beginning as it felt like it jumped right in to a story already being told. I felt like I had missed a few chapters! But after continuing on, the story and flow got much better. Interested to see where this series goes!

I have never read a series before where I have no clue who are the good guys are and who are the bad guys. Every time I think I have it figured out something would happen that would again leave me clueless yet still enthralled with every written word. Every question I had at the end of the first book was answered in the second, but this book also gave me a ton of new questions. We find out who Kat, Blaine, and Reese parents are in this book and it makes you glad that they grew up away from them. Aren't parents supposed to love you and help you? not try to kill you? Story picks up with Kat being able to avoid Blaine and all demons and reapers for two months while trying to resume a normal life; until a sexy new neighbor moves in next door. I was so excited when Blaine caught up to her, I never thought I would be one to cheer for the bad guy but then again Blaine is seriously hot with the whole "you are my mate" attitude. Reese and the professor are trying to help Kat break the mating bond while Blaine is trying to protect her from the demons, hellhounds, reapers and the Angel of Death that want her dead. Kat is such a likable character because she acts what I think a normal teenager girl would. She jumps to conclusion at everything that happens, and she is usually wrong. She does what she needs to do to prevent the final stage of completing the bond while also trying to remain "good". I like how she tells Blaine she wants to stop being a victim and learn to fight back. Blaine is a complicated character. I do not know if he is good, or if he is evil; if he is lying to Kat or protecting her from the truth. His devil may care attitude and sarcastic comments really had me laughing out loud a lot in the book. "friend of yours" "do you really think he would be eyeing me like a Happy Meal if it was?" First time ever I am cheering for the bad guy. Also I was in tears when we get the car crash where Kat dies in the first book from his point of view. That chapter wow. Reese is still a mysterious character but you learn more about him in this book that makes you feel sad for him and also makes you wonder if he isn't a "ct" who he says he is in regards to helping Kat. Which side is he really on and why does he know just

the right amount of information to keep Kat informed enough to keep her alive yet not enough to keep her safe. This book has everything I like in a series; suspense, new characters, intrigue, sexual tension, and just enough information to explain what is really going on while still blowing your mind with "did not see that coming" scenes. I would have liked for her to have been more of a connection/reminder of the "normal life" before all this happened. I think that would have served as a good juxtaposition for all the crazy that goes down in this book. I LOVE that KAT isn't afraid of a fight. Though, I do wish she was coming by it of her own accord, rather than it being "from" Blaine. But I get it. Also, when are we going to get a REAL taste of what this Prince of Lust is all about. I mean, Reese has been more hands on than Blaine. I'm so excited for book 3.

I just finished reading and I'm literally speechless and have an extreme book hang over! Insidious put me in a book slump for weeks, I couldn't pick up another book. This sequel was action packed, easy to follow, and incredibly simple to get caught up in! I literally could not put it down! Well done Victoria on another fantastic book! I had read so many books in between the first and second I wasn't sure I would be able to jump right back in it but WOW was I wrong.
