

This book covers just about everything a rug weaver needs to know except the basics. I have been a weaver for several years so the terms were very well known to me but someone just starting out would be totally lost. Mr. Collingwood is often acknowledged as the go to source for rug weaving and this book sure showed me why. If you have some weaving knowledge and are aware of the terms used by weavers you will find this book very useful not just for rugs but it also gave me a lot of ideas on how to alter drafts for more common things like towels, runners, scarves, etc. I'm also equally sure that tapestry weavers will be thrilled with learning new ways of doing things as well. A few of the things covered are variations on tabby, twills, blocks, use of color, selvage treatments, finishings, piles, cut piles. Detailed drawings and descriptions are what makes the book well worth the cost not just for rug weavers but for all weavers.
