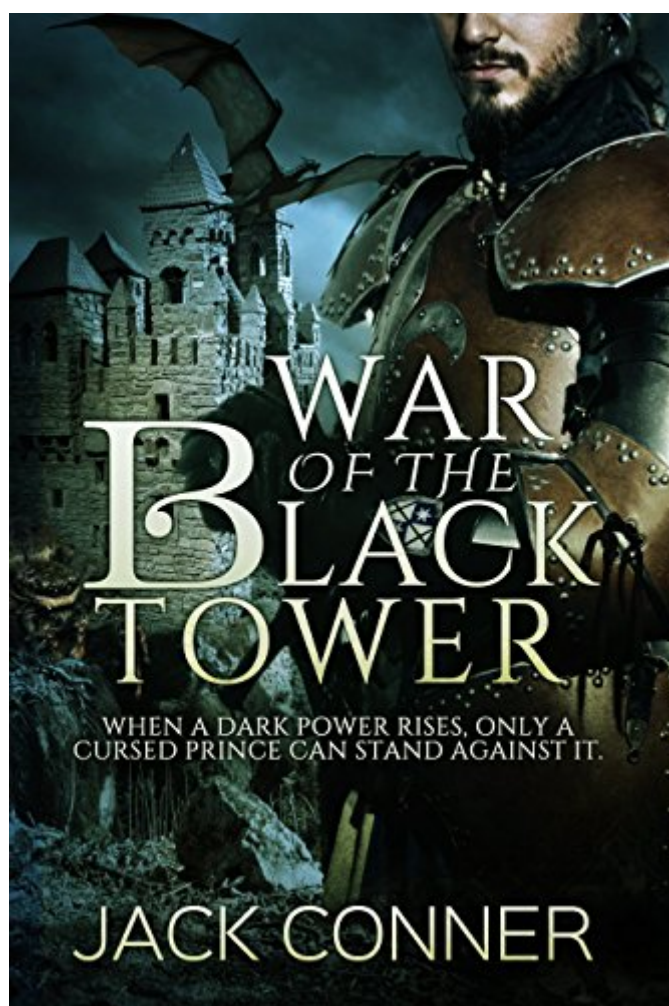

An exciting plot, attention to detail, but best of all fleshed out, well-written and well-rounded character development. This interesting and compelling work, as I said, had my attention from the beginning. The novel is paced faced, with lots of twists and turns that will take the reader on an intriguing journey. The setting is very much like Lord of the Rings, but not. I wish there were more epic fantasy novels out there like there like this one! The character development, as I said is fantastic, the storyline flows effortlessly, and the writing is absolutely stellar. The descriptions are so vivid you feel like you are right there within the pages of the book. Seriously, once you start, you will not want to put this book down for any reason. As someone who has read and re-read Tolkien stories for years, I was instantly drawn to this book. Baleron is a debonair rascal but he does love his family. I could just see the precarious glint in his eyes as he did things that were mischievous including his womanizing. He was instantly my favorite character. Even when I found out he had some serious issues brewing, I felt he would find a way to do the right thing. There is a good amount of drama and suspense throughout and I was thoroughly immersed within a few minutes. This is a fast paced read- nothing drags. This book quickly became a favorite read. It was the first I read by this author but definitely will not be the last. I could see this book being made into a movie as it has all the right elements.
