

I purchased a copy of Reason. Solve. Create for my daughter who is a junior after her private college advisor recommended this book. She had tried to work with many other test prep books from large companies. She even took a group class for five weeks from a big name educational company. We thought we would try a different book because she needs instruction in the actual content that is covered on the tests (English, Math, Reading, Science, and Essay). Many other books on the market just contain a lot of practice questions and practice tests but no actual lessons. This book is much more rigorous. It is actually more like a textbook. The English/Writing chapter, for example, contains lessons that cover every grammar, punctuation, sentence structure, and style/usage rule you could see on both exams. And the best part is that one book covers both the ACT and SAT. She is more mathematically inclined, so we learned through the use of this book that she should actually focus her efforts more on the SAT. The best part is we went to the company's website and contacted them and the president of the company called me the same day. She is now working one-one-one with one of the company's instructors that wrote this actual book! He has been really helpful and is even going to prepare her for the SAT Subject Tests and is tutoring her in AP Language and Pre-Calculus Honors. It is really nice that the book makes it clear what the differences are between the new SAT and the ACT. It also includes a really useful formula review sheet, appendix with defined terms that relate back to terms that were defined throughout the book, and a preface where the authors talk about their approach and experience in teaching students one-on-one. I would purchase the book again. It's unique to be able to speak with and get tutored by

the same people that wrote the book and teach privately as a career.

Simply put, I am very impressed. As a junior currently studying for both the ACT and SAT, I have been looking for a handbook that would guide me through both tests. This is the only one that I've been able to find that covers both tests and their idiosyncrasies at length. A friend of mine recommended that I purchase this book for my daughter, a junior taking her ACT exam this April. I've always been skeptical of test prep guides since they seem to be full of "tips and tricks" and rather lacking on actual content review. However, I have been very impressed with this book. It contains a thorough review of all the grammar and punctuation on the ACT, as well as comprehensive review of all the math concepts that come up on the test. Being a math teacher myself, I was impressed with the comprehensiveness of the math content. This book fulfills the needs of many students who are either trying to decide whether to take the SAT or ACT or to take both. It is extremely thorough and well written. It is obvious that the writers have spent many years working closely with students and have learned how to address their needs. In a future edition, I would like to see more explanations for questions and perhaps more essay samples with explanations for scores. My school has the College Board's SAT book and the official ACT guide in our library, but they offer vague suggestions like "find the best reading strategy for you." Well, what the heck does that actually mean? The practice tests are nice, but I miss questions and then can't even understand their explanations saying why I missed them. I also looked at some of the SAT resources available on Khan Academy, but they walked me through grammar questions with reasoning such as "That just doesn't sound right." This book offers real strategies and actually explains the concepts on the tests from both a technical and functional standpoint.
