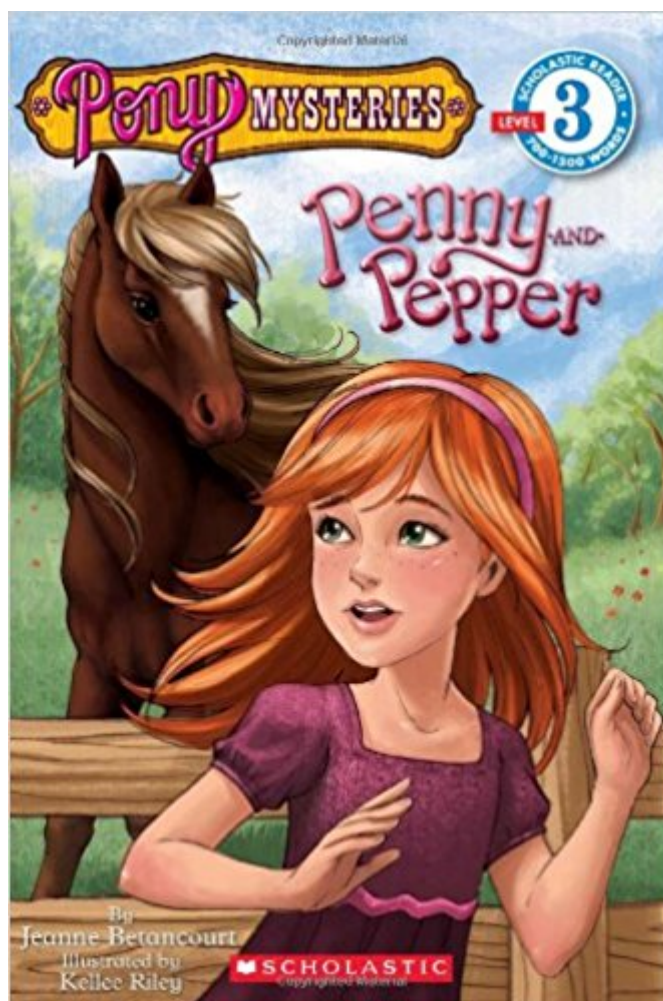

I love the illustrations and the colors. I liked the kids teaming up to solve a mystery. It will be interesting to see if the couple things that bother me about the story will matter to my granddaughter. The kitten stuck in a bush and then riding the pony didn't work for me. But that's an

adult perspective. I'm counting on her liking it because she needs easy readers and good ones are hard to come by.

I almost always have a few students that are just crazy about horses. I realized recently that my easy reader and easy chapter book collection lacked any horse books. This is one I bought to remedy that. It is predictable and I find the illustrations to be slightly strange. I think maybe the heads are too big for the bodies or something. . . it's hard to put my finger on but they just seem off. But I predict this book will be a hit anyway. It's a good length for a reader who is just about ready to tackle a chapter book but a little leary of picking a longer book. The book is only 33 pages long but broken into 5 chapters. Each chapter has only 3-5 pages. There are illustrations on most pages so the actual text is even less. I think it may appeal to some of my slightly older, struggling readers that love horses. It is not too babyish for a 8-9 year old although clearly aimed at slightly younger kids.

I love these series. But most important that my son does. I got 40+ books and he loves to read them (usually it is not that easy to make him read). I got mix of 2-3-4 levels for the second grader, second level is too easy, but it creates some fun and he reads them with pleasure. Love it, I would recommend it.
