I'm usually not sensitive to errors in books, but these were frequent and distracting. A decent editor would have tipped this book over to the 5 star rating.

I'm a big fan of the Beauty & the Beast re-tellings - this is a very different style than McKinley - but for the type of story Ms Gannon is going for it is fun, and I've always liked a good bad guy. I read the book in one weekend. ** Caution Spoilers Below *** The ending was happily ever after, new baby that's 'cursed' too, but of course it isn't really a curse and everyone is building a great new future and kingdom. The real reason I rated the book 4 stars is b/c of the Beasts character - he's mentally and somewhat physically abused by his dad as a kid. As an adult he's an jerk face with adjustment issues. I just couldn't relate to him on some things. I could relate more with the Big Bad Wolf from her first novel, than I could with this version of the Beast, IMHO.

Avenant grabbed onto my heart and held on tight. He's got *such* personality! I absolutely love him. He was entertaining as hell in the first book, and is more than entertaining in this one. He's deeper and so much more real and I got very invested in him and his story. I love it when the characters feel so strongly, deeply, and intensely that you have no choice but to feel it too, and be heart-hurt for them when the story calls for it. Just to be completely swept up in their story is the best experience

to have when reading. Cassandra gives you that. She manages to create a conflict that makes both characters make complete sense. Even when they're being ridiculous you can't blame them, you just want good things for them. It's so easy to root for that snarky *rightful* king and his sweet, sensible, usurper. And their story is so perfectly set that you never get bored. There's always something new and fantastic to get caught up in. This is such a fun read to get swept up in and I highly recommend it. I can't wait for Esmeralda's story!

I read both books in this series. Rarely am I so impressed with an author's imagination. I loved how Ms. Gannon made the characters believable, mixing old traits with new. Definitely recommend both books. I was so thoroughly engaged with Wicked Ugly Bad that I promptly bought everything published by this author. I adored the snarky beast and couldn't wait to get to know him more in this book.

This was so much fun to read. It's a unique combination of the classic fairytale and the Disney version set in a modern type setting. Only reason it got 4 stars instead of 5 was a kind of abrupt and somewhat awkward first sex scene. Seemed out of place and not very romantic. Otherwise great, great, great. It's one to read more than once.

Looking for a departure from the typical fairy tale? Look no further. True love gets turned upside down with every page. The characters are lovable screw-ups and rooting for the "bad guys" is all you want to do. I suggest reading Wicked Ugly Bad first just because it gives you more insight to this book, but even if you begin with this one you'll still be hooked. All I can say is I cannot wait for the next book!!!

The story was fun, and the dialogue often very witty. It definitely could have used better editing as there were a number of typographical errors that would jar me out of the story. Certainly less errors than I've seen in other self-published works. Overall I liked it quite enough to want to find out what happened to the remaining WUB Club.

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
