

Rick Elice with Marshall Brickman wrote the book for the Broadway musical Jersey Boys which received a Tony Award nomination and a Drama Desk nomination for best book for a musical in 2006. With Roger Rees, he wrote the popular thriller, Double Double, which has been translated into 16 languages. Elice was creative director at Serino Coyne, Inc., where he produced advertising campaigns for more than 300 Broadway shows including A Chorus Line and The Lion King. In 2008, he co-wrote Turn of the Century with Marshall Brickman. The show was directed by Tommy Tune and premiered at The Goodman Theatre in Chicago in September 2008. Elice most recently collaborated with Brickman once again, this time writing the book for the musical, The Addams Family.

I love this show very much - I saw it once at NYTW and three different times on Broadway. Rick Elice did a terrific job putting together this amusing script (and did a wonderful job editing it, too--the

show certainly evolved from OB to previews and again to opening). If you want to reminisce about your visit to the show, this is the perfect book for you. Not only does it have the entire script, but it has fun facts to go along with it. I laugh just reading aloud the Christian Borle trunk scene over and over again.

This book was much bigger and nicer than I expected. Peter and the Star Catcher was the highlight of our NYC trip last summer and my daughter asked for this book for Christmas. She read it cover to cover. She absolutely loved it!

This was purchased as a gift for my daughter and she assures me it was a FIVE STAR purchase. I have seen her reading it several times so I'll take her at her word!

This is my most favorite production of all time. The pictures, sketches, commentary, etc. simply make it come more to life on the pages than the typical script. I can open up script and fall back into a world that I love dearly. This is worth your time if you are a fan of Peter and the Star Catcher.
