

This is an extremely small book - about 4x7 inches, 97 pages To be honest, if I had seen it in a store (rather than on-line) I would have rejected it as overpriced. It describes 24 hikes. Since I am not native to the area, I don't know if they are the "best" in the area, but I'm sure many others were omitted in the interest of brevity. We purchased the book from in preparation for a week-long trip to

the area in July. The contents are useful, but limited. Directions to trail heads, maps and text for finding your way along the trail vary in quality and are quite brief. The maps are small and do not have topo lines. One useful aspect of the book is seasonal and terrain advice, which seemed to be quite accurate. The geographical range of the book extends in a radius about 50 miles from Santa Fe, but does not cover Taos or ABQ.

Well-chosen hikes, great descriptions, and good maps!
