I think if it had been professionally looked at, a lot of those simple fixes could have been taken care of. Overall, I give this story three and a half stars.

The book had a few typos that made it hard to understand, otherwise it was pretty interesting, Except I honestly hated the main character. For a therapist, she was the stupidest therapist when it came to her own life. But I guess it makes sense since she just got out of college and was in that "know-it-all" type state. But, I still think that she had no idea what she was doing. It was almost like she had taken a few classes and said, "I think I've got this I don't need anymore.
