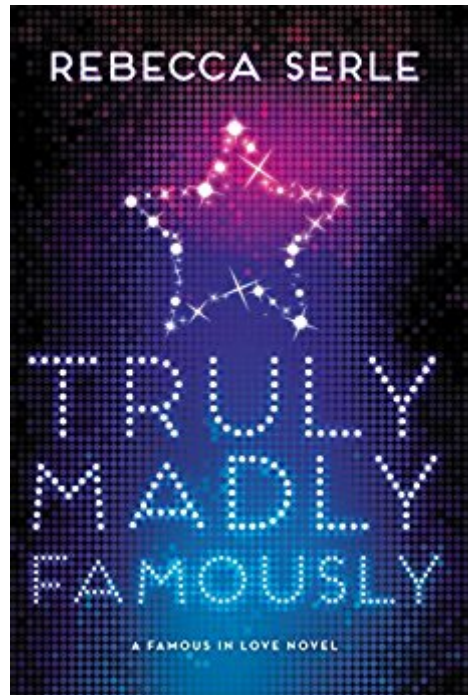

I enjoyed this sequel and the fact that it went a bit deeper - when most romances only skim the surface. I ordered this book because after watching season 1, I wanted to see how everything

ended. I really didn't know what was going to happen. The main character matured a lot in the second book, but Paige lost some of her innocence that made her so loveable in the first book.
