


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The Nyingma School Of Tibetan Buddhism: Its Fundamentals And History

One could not categorise Nyingma School as an ordinary book. It is a translation of teachings and the pure mind retrospective knowledge of the amazing activities of past masters from the eminent Dudjom Rinpoche, one of the greatest Tibetan Buddhist masters of this century and a living Buddha. His incarnation has reappeared. An ordinary person could spend 20+ years digesting this discourse. This particular book, which is a cheaper and more economical printing of a two-book box set, is a chance for anyone to access this superlative material much more easily. Recently, a bookseller in Kathmandu wanted to charge me \$USD 500 for the original box set. Years ago, you could buy it for about \$200. The price has shot through the sky! So, if you want a collector's item, buy the original box set but if you simply want the wisdom and inspiration, this book will rip your mind apart.

The two volumes are both extremely useful for anyone seriously interested in Buddhist philosophy in general and Tibetan Buddhism in particular. Dudjom Rinpoche gives a thorough, encyclopedic overview of all Buddhist schools, seen from the Nyingma (i.e. The Great Perfection, or Dzogchen) perspective, and an account of the history of the Nyingma lineage is given. The reference volume

contains amongst other items a brilliant bibliography. Dudjom Rinpoche's work is not easy reading, but demonstrates the complexity of Buddhist thinking and practice. Gyurme Dorje's translation is annotated and is in itself a remarkable feat in buddhology and tibetology.

What is the use of pursuing the causal path to bring about the stabilization of thought in the distant future? Merely introduce the open and vast expanse, primordially pure and liberated from the very beginning. This will stabilize all but the deluded and the mad. It stands instantaneously on the firm ground of awareness, as that ground. The irony is, of course, that this book [and many like it] is a causal agent. Immediate revelation has its transformative concatenation. And what a candid secret agent Dudjom Rinpoche is! The agent that calibrates perception and, immediately absorbed, takes immediate effect; the open, vast expanse is immediately uncovered, tremulous in the emptiness of the text. The fundamentals of ati-yoga are everywhere exposed and on display. This book is an instrument in the appearance of the world. How brazen! Heroic, after the flight from Tibet. And what a big book it is - excellent for hitting dolt-heads over the head with! I celebrate this accumulation. With profound and easy scholarship the author details the niceties and ins and outs of the Great Perfection and the Nyingmapa, school of ancient translation. And then the History is lengthy to wade through, but it has its gems. And delineates its line of succession, which is an unending causation until this day. As it says in The Penetration of Sound: The limit of the natural Great Perfection Leaves all things where they arise. Because appearance and consciousness are coalescent in reality, it reaches the total presence of primordial liberation. Its intention transcends the intellect, Distinctive phenomena are pure where they arise, It is free from the extremes of emptiness and substance, Movement has ceased, there are no conceptions, And, thoughts exhausted, the intellect is transcended. Become aware of this book. Awareness is that of which it is aware. This book is the end of the line.

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
