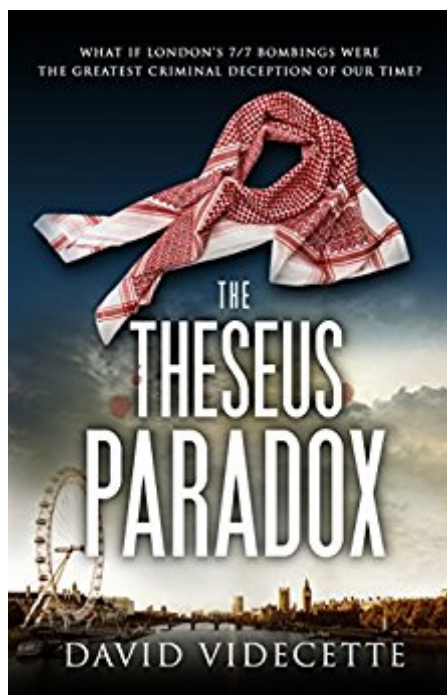

Meet detective Jake obsessed with his police work and long-legged women. He is willing to go beyond his job description and not afraid of using unconventional methods when needed. His gut feeling tells him the Police are looking in the wrong direction for the suspects of the 7/7 and 21/7 bomb attacks. Jake feels the suicide bombers have been set up and knows there is only one way to find the real culprits, the men behind the scenes, by taking a step back and focusing on the bigger picture. That is what he will do and he has no intention of failing. David Vidécette, you have created a true-to-life character in an exciting thriller, capturing the situation regarding the 2005 bombings so well we can easily imagine the events happening the way the author describes them. Jake is such a great character you simultaneously love and hate him. He demands that his team be fully focused on the job and yet he is not! He is in need of a wake-up call to realise how self-destructive his behaviour is but, then again, he is an excellent detective with all the right instincts. It is confusing, exhilarating and sometimes downright irritating when Jake again gives in to the lure of alcohol or lust. The novel is well-written and the short chapters are in line with the urgency of Jake's mission as well as the pace of the novel. A remarkable thriller providing us with insights into Police procedure and how the different branches of the Police sometimes have difficulty cooperating! Through his book, the author didn't simply take me on a fast-paced journey, as other thrillers normally do. No, I feel as

This story made me reflect on the current situation in the world, on the horrible news we're used to hear almost every day now. It also made me aware of how vulnerable to acts of terrorism we actually are. We can never be 100 percent safe, anywhere. We can never know when a terrorist attack is planned to strike. Crafted around real-life horrific events occurring in London in 2005, this story is so believable that it made me wonder whether what I was reading was fiction or not. I'm still not sure. What I know is that my heart was in my mouth throughout. The main character is DI Jake Flannagan of the Metropolitan Police, Anti-terrorist Branch. He's a brilliant, fearless detective, however his personal life is in shambles. He's riddled by guilt and anger. His Achilles heel - women and alcohol - he can't stay away from them." He was a toy. As you might imagine, this book is jam-packed with action, and twists and turns from start to finish, as we follow Jake on his dangerous quest to find the truth behind the bombings. Ignoring internal politics and conflicts within the Met and Security Service, he follows his instinct and does not always follow procedures or his superiors' orders, and he worries very little about the consequences. Investigating these horrific suicide bombings, he's determined to dig deep for the truth. Why have these attacks taken place and by whom? Who is behind them? Who pushed these suicide bombers to do what they did? Having been directly involved in the original bombings' investigation, it shows that the author knows too well what he's writing about. And it's evident that a lot of research has been undertaken. The prose is excellent with realistic dialogues. The plot is believable, intricate, detailed and well planned to keep the reader's interest high. Short chapters, all headed with day, time and location make reading a so much more interesting and enjoyable experience. I found myself reading at night with my eyes half closed just to find out what happens in the next chapter. This is a gripping, fast-paced read that I really enjoyed. Contrary to some other readers I really like the book's cover. I think it's ideal. The chequered scarf looming over the London skyline is symbolic of this book.
