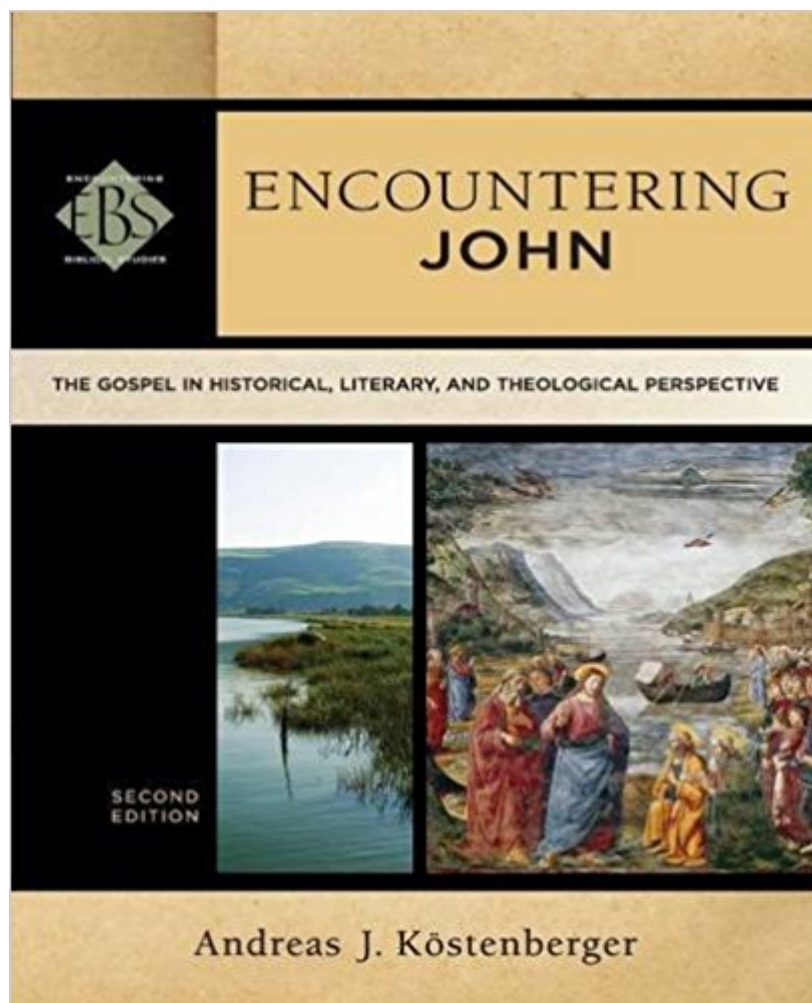




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Encountering John: The Gospel In Historical, Literary, And Theological Perspective (Encountering Biblical Studies)
