


The book was found

A good start to a new series! I liked the premise of the story and was intrigued about the parallel universe. I think it's more of a 3.5-4 stars overall kind of read. I liked Finnie well enough, but wished she'd stood up more for herself, or at least explain she's not used to how things work there (after she realizes Frey knows) and how she's used to living. I realize she has to learn and adapt to her new surroundings, but there were times I would've straight up stood my ground, but I'm also a very

strong willed woman (lol). I also thought her vocabulary was a little on the juvenile side too many times: crap, ho boy, freaking, cool, etc. Frey is a bit TOO pushy/bossy/demanding for my likes, but he also had his sweet moments. I get it, he's a ruler and should be listened to, but there are several times in the story I would've straight up blown up on him for saying/doing what he does to Finnie and I doubt I'd be easily forgiving him like how she does in the story. I felt it was a little dragged out, a little too descriptive, and sometimes a bit repetitive, but otherwise I enjoyed the story and will continue on with book 2.

I will be the first to admit I am not a big fan of Fantasy like at all. Give me paranormal vamps, wolves, bears, but knowing that I am a HUGE Kristen Ashley fan I thought give it a shot. I AM SO GLAD I DID! Not only was it easy to read and follow along but the story was wonderful and sweet! I rooted for Seoafin aka Finnie right from the very beginning.

I thought that the storyline was very interesting. I loved the idea of an alternate world with a twin living a completely different life from our own. I did not like how the story began already in progress. The main character had somehow already found out about the alternate world and booked transport to said world. Also, the main character's awe with the new world she found herself in was wonderful. At first. Then, it was annoying, followed by ridiculous. If I had to read, "It was so cool," one more time, I was going to scream. So, yep. You guessed it! I screamed!! The male lead was the most frustrating man I have read about in quite some time. Some of the things he did and thought would have made any woman from this world leave him at the drop of a hat. And luckily, this anger was shown, albeit briefly, from our heroine. In summary, the book was ok. It held my interest. I just wanted it to be better. Also, the narrator was really good on the audio book.

I was one of those doubters who left this series for last. I love every Kristen Ashley book that I've read, but parallel universe, magic, witches and even dragons? I had my doubts. Boy was I proven wrong!! Right from the opening paragraphs I was drawn in by the magic that is a KA story. Finnie is a kick-ass heroine, snarky and sarcastic and just always ready to take on an adventure.

"You know, marriage is marriage, a partnership. You aren't the only one who needs to step up and keep one of us safe. It's my job as your wife to do the same if a time comes when I have to and it's my job to do it however that might need to come about." Frey Drakkar who is waiting at the end of the aisle when Finnie finds herself transported, is quite gruff and scary at first. But I was soon swooning for his brand of

alpha! While dealing with politics and assassination attempts, Frey works to keep Finnie bound to him and his land. "You are, my wee Finnie, beyond my wildest dreams." Amazing fantasy and Kristen Ashley combine to make this the start of an epic series. For a re-read, I listened to this on audiobook. The narrator, Tillie Hooper does an amazing job painting the world that Finnie finds herself in. Great voice! She kept me enthralled!!

Holy guacamole! I wasn't quite prepared for the level of graphic sexual content, but Kristen Ashley's characters are so engaging that I was sucked right into the whole deal. The story moves a little slow, but she is working hard to help the reader really understand the characters, so it works. Sure, it's a fantasy, and sure, things work out well and it's all lovely. But this book was seriously entertaining. In addition to the quite hot sex, I found myself laughing at times and even getting a bit teary. Romances have never been my thing; but this book was so engaging, that I seriously couldn't put it down. One of the reasons I've not liked romances is that the heroine often is too mopey, or too stupid, or too much of a victim. Kristen Ashley's heroine is someone you immediately like, then later pretty much fall in love with. After I read this one, I couldn't wait to pick up another, and another, etc. I just finished this Fantasyland Series, 5 books in all, and I really enjoyed it.
