I own a few of Sherri Baldy's coloring books and was really happy to see that she had released one that features Halloween designs. The designs feature her cute little big eye girls in various poses and costumes. There are lots of cute designs and, as with all of her coloring books, she provides you with two copies each of the 25 designs in the book. I really appreciate that as it allows me to explore two color ways with each design or to share a design with a friend. There are pirates, witches, animals and lots of pumpkins with easy to color designs. I have a lot of fun coloring these see little girls. I like to color these in between more difficult and complex projects. It's wonderful to have something to color that I can easily finish in an afternoon. My preference for coloring her

designs is to use markers and then colored pencils on top for details and shading. This is what I experienced while coloring in this book and testing the paper with my various coloring medium: 25 x 2 Big Eye Girls in Halloween costumes (50 total pages to color) Printed on one side of the page Paper is typical for CreateSpace publications - white, thin, slightly rough and non-perforated Glue Bound Designs do not merge into the binding area Alcohol and water based markers all bleed through the page though alcohol bleed through more fully and quickly while water based spot through. Gel pens and India ink pens leave colorful shadows at the back of the page. India ink can bleed through if you use repeated layers or try to blend several colors. Colored pencils work well with this paper. Both oil and wax based could be used with a light or firm hand. I use a light hand and get good pigment color by repeated layers and use of my blending pencils. Layering and blending work well with this paper. My hard lead pencils like Verithins dent or score through to the back of the page. I use and recommend the use of a blotter page of some sort. I use card stock but heavyweight paper or several sheets of regular white paper work as well.

This was my 2nd book of her's to buy and there's such a huge difference between the two! In her first book everyone is "fluffy" and the eyes are mostly just an eyelash. In this book the eyes are fully opened and I'm not sure why it was done like this or what I'm supposed to do with the space in between the bottom of the eye and the lash? So I didn't do anything and IMO it just looks weird. Also was a little disappointed with so many of the same theme being used over and over. Witches. Granted I made some into magicians instead but still there's ALOT of starry hats that were IMO just over done. The other pet peeve was the mummy. It's white and /or beige ie boring. Why even include such when there's so many other costumes in the world? So I was aggravated the book is filled with witches and 2 pages has a frickin mummy! SMH Yes they're cute and all but I took this on vacation during Halloween and honestly got BORED! The first book I couldn't put it down and colored every single one of those pics! Even bought it again to do over in pencil instead of gel pen. I mostly use gel pens as I'm disabled and it's harder to use any other medium. IMO it seems like Sherri got stuck on a theme and stayed with it throughout the book. See my pics for reference. So if you, like me, aren't a fan of witches then you won't enjoy this book. PLEASE release a 2nd Halloween book that has more variety and I promise to buy it!

My-Besties Halloween Boo Coloring Book Volume #13 is the first coloring book from Sherri Baldy. I am also new to the "big eyes" genre of coloring books. I first tried the Lacy Sunshine's series as I thought they looked similar. This is until My-Besties Book arrived. This book is impressed me in the

following ways.+ it is a full size coloring book.+ the pictures are large with details to each of the girls+25 pictures each with a duplicate copy. This is a feature I like because, I have often bought a second copy of a favorite book to use my two favored media gel pen / marker and watercolor/color pencil combinations+ The book includes a index of all the pictures inside. A feature I first saw in this book.+ Each of these designs would appeal to adults and children.Only one drawback to note- the paper quality isn't very thick~ my gel pens leave a ghost image on the back but doesn't bleed all the way through. A slight wave to the page upon drying can be seen.~ My permanent markers and fineliners bleed through into a watercolor like look*Tip I use a piece of cardboard from a calendar packaging to protect my other pages. I tape one or two pieces of construction paper to the cardboard and, change the paper periodically.Overall I was impressed with this book. I have enjoyed my experience and will definitely buy other books in the series. I would recommend this author to others.

This is my first Sherri Baldy My-Besties book. Overall, i am very pleased with the variety of adorable pictures. It really doesn't matter to me if there are 2 of the same picture. I really wish the pages were perforated! You can't color in the book, without the risk of damaging the binding and it is very hard to cut the page out of the book, without risk of cutting the picture. My markers also bled thru the back of the page.

A cute coloring book for everyone to enjoy. I definitely recommend this one for coloring around Halloween time. It is a really fun one to color in. It has adorable pictures to color.
