

However, we found the information it contained to be so scant that we barely used it for a single place we visited; we looked up each location, but found very little of substance in the book. Rather, I suggest the traveler take the copy of the free Honduras guidebook that we found available at every hotel or lodge in which we stayed. *ÃƒÂ¢Ã ¬Ã œ yeah, sure, cheaper paper, but more information.* To find restaurants, lodging, or sights, just check out TripAdvisor or follow your nose. The only thing of value we found was that there was a very brief presentation of Honduran history.
