

This is an excellent text for general coverage of the Reformation. It is packed with information, and has a lot of valuable detail (particularly of a philological and theological nature) set out in a way that the general reader can grasp. It is a little boring and shallow here and there -- one longs for more quotes and stories from the period to liven things up, but you can't have everything. It is pretty well a perfectly workable intro to the period. The Kindle edition is riddled with typos (runon words). No idea why that is, perhaps it is just a basic Kindle flaw.

While I haven't yet finished this book it is extremely enjoyable to read and simply written to give a good overview of the reformations going on in and around Europe from the beginning stages. Can't wait to finish it!
