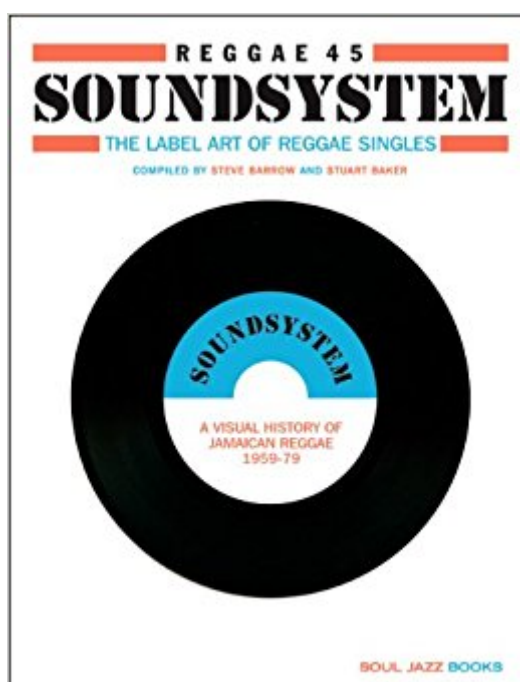

The book is edited by Soul Jazz founder Stuart Baker.
