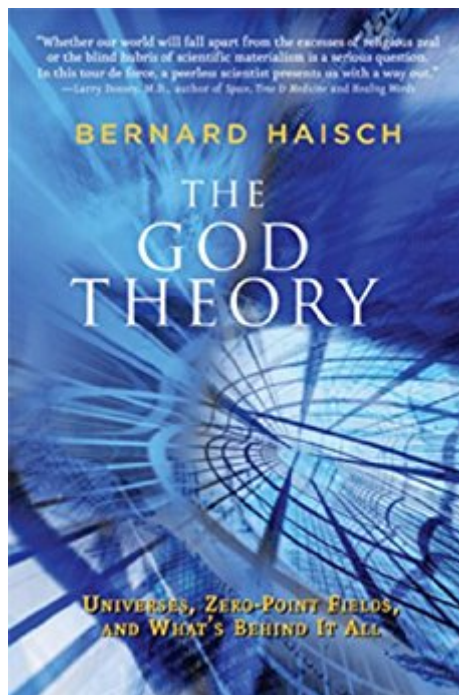

Although the author takes pains to present his scientific bona fides, this is not a work of science, or even a serious attempt to reconcile science with faith. It is a statement of faith. Other reviewers have accurately described the tenets of the book, and I found some of the author's beliefs agreeable. But his arguments are almost anti-intellectual in their scornful glibness, and one of his favorite "proofs" - the large anthropic principle - has been discredited as a proof of a God for decades. In the end, I dislike his appropriation of facts to support his beliefs almost as much as I dislike Richard Dawkins' (who is otherwise one of my favorite authors) contempt for spiritual yearnings.

Finally, a man of science who isn't a reductionist or atheist. I'm fascinated with the balanced suggestions made by Dr. Haisch concerning the origins of the universe and our place in it. He brings a wealth of backgrounds to his analysis - born in Germany, Catholic schooling with some seminary training and followed by a diverse group of secular universities. And with his two PhDs - one of them in astrophysics, he seems able to look at the big picture in an exciting new way. I'm impressed - nothing is written and nothing is carved in stone. Only intelligent, far reaching inquiry.
