

When the apostle Paul was teaching, believers in Corinth faced this struggle, and Paul wrote letters 1 and 2 Corinthians to help them. Bible teacher Ray Stedman uses Paul’s writings to the Corinthian Christians to guide us through difficult matters and moral “gray areas.” We are all bombarded with the immoral influences of the culture around us, but God stands firm on what He says in Scripture. Letters to a Troubled Church pinpoints the truth as God intended, offering encouragement for Christians today.

Ray C. Stedman (1917–1992) was one of the great pastors, expositors, and spiritual leaders of the twentieth century. A graduate of Dallas Theological Seminary, he was pastor of the

Peninsula Bible Church in Palo Alto, California, for 40 years. With over 20 books to his credit, from the empowering Spiritual Warfare to his insightful commentary Adventuring through the Bible, Stedman spanned the experiences of the Christian life with his writing. His book Body Life had a tremendous impact on the church in the twentieth century.

Ray Stedman does it again. Learning of the trials of the early church, has given me a much greater appreciation that the church is still in existence today. Next to Romans, this is probably my favorite of the Pauline epistles.

Stedman always gives a fresh yet scholarly approach to any Bible book. He writes as a theologian and pastor, for head and heart. Pastors will find it valuable.
